

In connection with the questions received to the following request for proposal:

No. 21/2021–ARG

Professional consulting services related to the preparation of the specification for impurity and conducting a gap analysis for the CMC data package in the OATD-02 research program

we provide answers to questions that has arisen up to 08/04/2021 13:00 (CET).

Question: Can you advise the timing of this work? When you hope to have this work done?

Answer: The gap analysis for the CMC data package in the OATD-02 research program should be prepared in 2 parts divided in time: separately for DS and DP. This is due to the fact that at the moment OAT only has documentation from DS production (and it will be possible to prepare the gap analysis from this part immediately after signing the contract and submitting the documentation by the OAT team). As for the documentation from DP production, it is not yet available, because in April OAT will sign a contract with the DP manufacturer. OAT anticipates that documentation on DP production should be available at the turn of Q1/Q2 2022.

According to the documentation, the service contract will be valid until September 30, 2022.

Question: Can you clarify what this means the clause: “ We declare that the offer does not contain confidential information within the meaning on counteraction to unfair competition acts*”and what sort of confidential information should not be provided in order to comply with this legislation?

Answer: The statement that the offer does not contain or contains information constituting a confidential information (business secret) within the meaning on counteraction to unfair competition acts is our standard provision in each request for the proposal. It results from the provisions of the Act on combating unfair competition.

According to the law confidential information is understood as technical, technological, organizational information of a company or other information having economic value, which as a whole or in a specific combination and set of its elements are not commonly known to people who usually deal with this type of information or are not easily accessible to such information, as long as the person authorized to use the information or dispose of it has taken steps with due diligence to keep it confidential.
